### SYA Parent Participation Information

CONCESSION STAND – At uniform pickup, a \$50 deposit will be left for the concession stand. You will be assigned a day and time that you must work in the stand. Your \$50 deposit will be returned to you after your shift. If you do not work your shift, your \$50 deposit will be forfeited.

All players are REQUIRED to participate in TWO fund raising efforts to help offset operating costs.
