All players who sign up will be given the opportunity to try out for our Lehigh Valley League teams. These teams play a slightly more competitive style of baseball in a more challenging league, and the program prepares the players for higher levels of baseball in the future. Evaluations are done in a relaxed environment, and all boys who do not make the LVL program will be placed on a CWL team. **We encourage all boys to participate in this process.**

Uniforms

All participants will receive a SYA hat, uniform shirt and pants, belt, and socks that will be their game uniform. A \$40 uniform deposit (LVL) will be required, and may be paid with a **separate check** at registration, or at the time uniforms are issued. Upon on-time return of the game uniform in acceptable condition (cleaned, no signs of unusual wear), the \$40 deposit will be refunded. All uniforms must be returned within two weeks of the end of the season, at dates/times specified by the Director, or the deposit will be forfeited.

Fundraising

All players are **REQUIRED** to participate in fund raising efforts to help offset operating costs. Each family must fulfill its financial obligation to SYA. If all fundraisers (or buy out) are not **fully** completed your child will not be eligible to participate in any program activities until all money is turned in.

For 2019, our combined Fundraiser will again be lottery tickets, which will be issued at signups. These tickets sell for \$10 each, and will run for April/May/June. Each family that does not do the buy-out at the time of registration will receive 20 tickets, and will be required to sell a minimum of 15 tickets, with the money to be returned to your coach no later than March 31st. **Families wishing to buyout of this fundraiser should pay \$100 at the time of registration – this represents the buyout for the “base” fundraiser common to the both programs.**

The CWL program will require all Biddy & Midget families to work in the Laubach Park Concession Stand at least once per season.

Because of increased costs involved in the LVL program, this program will have additional fundraising requirements. For 2019, the following options are available for this additional fundraising requirement:

- Sell the entire pack of 20 tickets given to you at the time of registration (5 additional lottery tickets)
- Sell the minimum 15 tickets (or do the \$100 buyout), then sell 20 hoagies or more as part of our second fundraiser
- Sell the minimum 15 tickets (or do the \$100 buyout), then do an additional \$30 buyout for the hoogie sale.
